| Japanese | English | Meaning |
|-------------------|-----------------------------------|--|
| 先輩 (Senpai) | Senior | A person who is ahead of you, i.e. someone older than you, or someone who has entered the office or school you work or attend before you, regardless of age |
| 後輩 (Kohai) | Junior | A person who is behind you, i.e. someone younger than you, or someone who has entered the office or school you work or attend after you |
| 同級生 (Dokyusei) | Classmate | A person who is in the same class or grade in the school as you |
| 同期 (Doki) | Peer (from the same period) | A person who has entered the workplace (or has entered/graduated the college/university) in the same year as you |
| 上司 (Joshi) | Boss | A person in a higher position than you at work |
| 部下 (Buka) | Subordinate | A person in a lower position than your boss at work |
| 同僚 (Doryo) | Colleague | A person in the same workplace (and in the same position) as you ♣ This word is mainly used when you introduce someone in your workplace to your family or friends. |
