	Glass Bottles • After emptying the contents, rinse with water.

Recyclables

Miscellaneous Papers

Empty Paper Boxes, Receipts, Photos, Carbon Papers, Waterproof Papers, Aluminum Coated Papers, Postcards, Envelopes

※Please tie papers up using paper or plastic strings, or put them into either a paper bag or transparent/semi-transparent plastic bag then seal the opening before disposing.
※Please put cardboard, paper packs, newspapers, flyers, and magazines to private collection boxes and PTA.

Aluminum Cans

•After emptying the contents, rinse with water.
•Do not remove the tab (lid).
•Remove bottle can caps.

Steel cans

•After emptying the contents, rinse with water.
•Do not remove the tab (lid).
•Remove bottle can caps.

Aerosol spray cans and Gas canisters

Hair sprays, Insecticide sprays, Gas canisters

※After using up the contents, release the gas inside via the cap attached to the can and pierce a hole in the can using a dedicated tool, in a well ventilated location clear of fire.

Glass Bottles

• After emptying the contents, rinse with water.

White or Transparent: Juice bottles, Jam jars, Seasoning jars, Cosmetics bottles

Brown: Beer bottles, 1,800 ml sake bottles, Vitamin drink bottles

Other colors: Juice bottles, Liquor bottles, Cosmetics bottles

※Sort glass bottles by color, and put all other colors besides white, clear, or brown into "Others[その他]".
※If it does not come clean even after washing, the contents have hardened, or it is broken, put it in "Kinds of Rubbles[がれき類]".
※It is not necessary to remove plastic that is stuck to the opening or to remove labels that are stuck on tight.

Metal Items and Small Electric Appliances

•Small electric appliances, except TV sets, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, clothes dryers, and personal computers. (Make sure to remove dry-cell batteries.)
•Items with a piece of metal
•Metallic lids
•Take items that do not fit in the container (74cmX49cmX35cm) on your own to a disposing facility.

Stoves, Fan heater
※Please remove the batteries and empty the kerosene out of the tank/body of the heater.

Frying pans, Umbrella, Kettles, Cooking pots

Dehumidifiers
※Remove CFC gas, etc.

Bicycles, Electric bicycles, Tricycles
※When disposing of bicycles, first cancel the anti-theft registration, then attach a paper with 「不用」(waste) or 「処分」(dispose) written on it.
※Remove batteries from electric bicycles. Ask a sales outlet for the removal and disposal.

Recyclable plastics

•Put them in the same net boxes as the plastic containers and packaging.
•Rinse them lightly with water to keep the surrounding items clean.

Plastic Containers and Packaging
Cooking oil bottles, Face-wash bottles, Liquid detergent bottles, Tubes

Food trays and various containers, Plastic tops (of PET bottles, etc.)

Plastic products
Styrofoam, Bubble cushioning material (bubble wrap), Bags for snacks, Cups for noodles, Plastic hangers, Buckets, Wash bowls, Plastic tableware

※For plastic products, both of the following conditions must be met:
(1) Made of 100% plastic only (no metal or rubber included)
(2) Less than 50 cm on a side

Plastic Pet Bottles

Items marked with [1PET]

※Put plastic tops and labels into "Recyclable plastics [資源プラスチック]".
※Please use up the contents of the containers and rinse them lightly before disposing.
※You do not need to remove a ring around the mouth of a PET bottle.

Used Cooking Oil

• Only vegetable oils

Items accepted: Vegetable oils thrown out from households (edible oil used in deep frying)
※Oils that use vegetable ingredients such as soybean oil, rapeseed oil, safflower oil, corn oil, olive oil, and salad oil.

※After cooling to room temperature, pour it via a strainer into a PET bottle or an empty plastic bottle for cooking oil that is either transparent or translucent, then close the lid.
※Empty bottles for edible oil usually have caps that easily come off, so it is recommended to use a PET bottle. If using empty bottles for edible oil, wrap the cap part and fix it with a rubber band.

Batteries

Dispose of non-removable rechargeable batteries (as part of the product) that fit in the container with these items.

Cylindrical dry-cell batteries, Manganese batteries, alkaline batteries, etc.
Rechargeable batteries (nickel-metalhydride batteries, and lithium-ion batteries)

Small Appliances With Non-removable Rechargeable Batteries (e.g.)
Portable chargers, Electric shavers, Wireless earphones

※To prevent shorts, put plastic tape on both the positive and negative terminals of rechargeable batteries.

Fluorescent Tubes

※Put cracked bulbs, incandescent lamps, light bulbs, and LED lamps in "Kinds of Rubbles[がれき類]".

•Clinical thermometers (containing mercury)
•Thermometers (containing mercury)
•Fluorescent Tubes
•Compact fluorescent light bulbs

Landfill Garbage

Kinds of Rubbles

• Take items that do not fit in the container (58cmX43cmX31cm) on your own to a disposing facility

Bricks, Concrete blocks, Pots, Roof tiles, Incandescent lamps, LED lamps

Aluminum foils, Aluminum containers, Mirrors (broken glass), Glass (broken glass)

Ash (灰), Ceramics (bowls, cups, dishes)

※Plasterboard/drywall cannot be collected by the city.
※Please put in a bag and indicate 「灰」(Ash).
•Put the following into the designated container:
Lighters (including stove lighter)
Remove the gas or use it completely.

Leather Products, Other Plastics, Sponges, etc.

• Plastics other than those with a plastic mark.
• Take items that do not fit in the container (74cmX49cmX35cm) on your own to a disposing facility
• Dispose of dirty plastics in the same container/place as the items here.

※You can also dispose of those that fit in combustible garbage bags designated by the city as "combustible garbage[燃やせるごみ]".

Sponges, Dirty styrofoam rolls, Cushioning Foam beads, Rubber gloves, Hoses, Helmets, Ice packs, Satchels, bage, Disposable body warmers, Boots, Shoes, Desiccant

Garbage not collected by the city

Tires, Auto parts, Motorcycles, Car batteries, Fire extinguishers, Bottles of agrochemicals, Solvent, Paint, Waste oil (motor oil, machine oil, kerosene, etc.), Plasterboard/drywall, TV sets, Air conditioner (including outdoor units), Washing machines, Clothes dryers, Refrigerators, Freezers
