

Useful Phrases for Talking About COVID-19

新型 コロナウイルスの役に立つフレーズ



①**クラスター(kurasuta): “Cluster”**. Originally means “group” or “crowd” in English. It is often used when talking about COVID-19 to describe a group of people who were infected in the same place. ②**オーバーシュート(obashuto): “Overshoot”**. When there is a sudden and dramatic rise in infections. ③**コロナ禍 (korona ka): “Corona Fallout”**. A term to describe the different worries and stresses caused directly or indirectly by COVID-19. ④**感染経路 (kasen keiro): “Transmission route”**. The way by which a person is infected by the virus. Mainly used in these contexts: 1) How did the virus enter the body of the infected person? (ie. via moisture droplets or contact with an infected person) 2) What kind of circumstances was the person infected in? (ie. heavy contact with another infected person or nosocomial infection? If the circumstances cannot be identified, the infection route is unknown)
